### July's Speaker John Buck





#### The Human Connection

Our July 25 guest speaker is John Buck, current president of the Camera Club of Brevard. John is going to show us how his photography has rewarded him with a deeper and more profound connection to others. As a contract photographer for Eastman Kodak from 1995 to 2009, John was responsible for providing international lifestyle images for use in trade shows, websites and other Kodak promotional and marketing vehicles such as kiosks and point-of-sale material. Kodak required people to be the primary subject and as such, John was tasked with capturing not only a technically sound RAW image, sometimes with a small consumer camera, but also names, addresses and a photo release from each subject or guardian. In essence, John usually had less than 5 minutes to get the image.

In his presentation John will explain how he was able to make the connections with subjects of all ages. He will also take us on a walk down a side street in Bogota, Colombia to demonstrate what he sees as compelling photographs.






